VARIETY

100% Gamay Noir from Old Vines

VINIFICATION

Mature grapes are harvested by hand, destemmed, and fermented with selected yeast in stainless steel vats to preserve natural aromas and flavors.

TERROIR

Millions of years ago, a north-south rift formed in the earth's crust giving rise to the highland that today forms the Beaujolais-Villages appellation area. Here, the complex soils made up of granitic, magmatic and metamorphic rock allow the Gamay Noir grape to express its personality brilliantly. Thirty-eight picturesque villages surround the hillside vineyards in the Monts du Beaujolais at 1,200 feet and give this AOC its name.

TASTING NOTE

This is a powerful expression of the Gamay grape, sourced from the finest vineyards across the appellation. Notes of rich red fruit combine with a long, satisfying finish to make this wine an excellent pairing with poultry and cheeses of all types.

ABOUT THE LABEL

Chantecler is the colloquial name for the Gallic Rooster. Claire Chanté Beaujolais-Villages is a subtle homage to this illustrious cockerel's resurgence during the French Revolution as a paragon of liberty, independence, and national symbol of France.
